EHCP Fact Sheet



What is an EHCP

An EHCP (Education, Health, and Care Plan) is a legal document in the UK designed to support children and young people up to the age of 25 who have special educational needs and disabilities.

It outlines the specific educational, health and social care needs an individual requires and how these should be met.

Post 16 Support

What support and funding is available

You may be eligible for the following:

- Finding for specialist coaching to support you into work
- Mental Health support
- Skills training in preparation for work

You must

- Be in education, training, supported internship or support apprenticeship
- Have a disability or health condition that affects your ability to work
- Live in England, Scotland or Wales

How do I get funding?

Coaching can be funded through EHCPs, but only if:

- It's specified in Section F
- It's clearly tied to an educational or training outcome
- You've got evidence from a relevant professional
- You can frame it in a way that's legally and practically sound
